CANLAN LAUNCHES OPERATIONS IN FORT WAYNE, INDIANA

Burnaby, B.C., February 22, 2010 – Canlan Ice Sports Corp. (TSX: ICE), providers of the on-ice experience to youth and adults across North America, today announced that its operations in Fort Wayne, Indiana are fully functional, following the opening of Ice Sports Fort Wayne, a newly constructed three-pad, 128,000 square foot sports and entertainment facility.

As announced previously, Canlan is leasing and operating Ice Sports Fort Wayne for a period of up to 20 years. Canlan also has an option to purchase the facility during the first seven years of the lease. As operators of Ice Sports Fort Wayne, Canlan offers multiple hockey and skating programs, including the Canlan Skating Academy, Hockey Academy and the Adult Safe Hockey League, North America's most successful adult recreational hockey program. Canlan will also be incorporating its signature brand, The Thirsty Penguin Grill House, in the facility's 200-seat full-service restaurant.

In addition to Ice Sports Fort Wayne, Canlan is also managing the city-owned facility in Fort Wayne. The building, which operates under the name McMillen Ice Arena, will be managed by Canlan for a period of up to 10 years.

"We are very encouraged by the local community's support for our efforts to establish thriving ice sports facilities in Indiana," said Joey St-Aubin, President and CEO of Canlan Ice Sports. "We look forward to introducing our programs, such as Canlan Classic Tournaments and the Adult Safe Hockey League, to the Mid-West, and continuing to grow the number of registered players."

Fort Wayne is centrally located between Indianapolis, Chicago and Detroit, enabling Canlan to execute its growth strategy in the U.S.

"Our new, state-of-the-art facility is not only a hub for our future expansion, it will also draw teams and skaters from three key market areas to experience firsthand why our motto is, 'Where the Experience is Everything,'" Mr. St-Aubin also said.
